The machine is a Singer XL420 Futura. It is a sewing and embroidery machine. However, we do not have several components for the embroidery functions but they are readily available online. The machine is a great one for quilting and regular sewing.

- SWIFTSMART Threading System is the biggest timesaver! Simply guide the thread directly from the spool to the needle area through a single groove and thread the needle by pressing the threading lever for truly one-touch needle threading
- With the DROP & SEW Bobbin System there is no need to pull up the bobbin thread manually. Simply insert the bobbin, place the thread in the channel and start sewing
- 6 STAYBRIGHT LED Lights on each side of the needle area as well as one light over the large surface to the right of the needle make it easier to see your work
- 30 Built-In Sewing Stitches-- 6 Basic, 5 Stretch, 17 Decorative and 2 Buttonholes

- Online YouTube instructional videos illustrate how to thread the machine and get started sewing.
- Heavy Duty Metal Frame holds all the mechanisms in perfect alignment for skip-free sewing and durability.

The machine comes with a power cord, foot pedal, user's manual, 2 boxes of bobbins, several presser feet, and the hoops for the embroidery part. It has a homemade dust cover but no hard case. The parts missing are the USB cord, CD, and extended table for embroidery. You would also need a computer to download the embroidery software.
