2 busy fabrics next to each other

Suggestion:

Contrasting fabrics.

Backgrounds:

Lighter or a mix of lighter greys & off whites or whites

Sewing Supply List:

Sewing machine - power cord & foot petal

Extra Needles

Appliqué Foot or straight foot

Neutral Thread for piecing

Neutral thread Loaded Bobbins

Monofilament Thread or matching thread to background fabric

Stiletto

Permanent Marking Pen & Pencil

Ball Point Bodkin

Point Turner/Seam Creaser Tool

Applique Press Sheet

Pins

Snips

Seam Ripper

Small bottle Elmers school glue or fabric glue

Pressing:

Small Travel Iron

Press pad

Clapper

Cutting:

6" x 12" Ruler

Small Rotary cutter to cut around acrylic templates

Cutting Mat

*Dresden template (Darlene Zimmerman)

*Acrylic circles or cut the different sizes on a Circuit or accuquilt (for perfect circles)

Scissors

Scissors to cut Mylar not fabric

Rotating cutting Mat

Cut your own templates

Mylar for templates if not using the acrylic rulers or cereal box to use as a template

Fabric:

Pressed Background Fabric - 13"

Blades: 5 different fabrics - Med to Dark Fabrics - cut @ 4 1/2 x 9"

Center: - 5 1/2 Square
