

Class: Beautiful, Bountiful Binding

Description: In this workshop you will finish a Kennel Quilt using Elmers Glue to attach the binding before sewing, create a 90-degree mitered corner, and machine finish using a straight or decorative stitch. Using the same method, a second quilt for Leaves in Time Perinatal Hospice will be completed.

Materials/Supplies

1. Sewing machine
 - a. Quarter-inch foot or what you use to piece
 - b. All feet for your sewing machine
 - c. System printed or digital manual
 - d. Optional equipment
 - i. Edge stitch foot
 - ii. Cording/beading foot
 - iii. Seam guide
2. Thread
 - a. A dark and light color
 - b. Variety of colors for decorative stitching
 - c. Wound bobbins of 'A' & 'B'
3. Scissors/thread snips
4. Seam ripper
5. Marking tool (e.g., chalk, pens)
6. Quilt clips (preferred) or straight pins
7. Old washcloth/towel – used to wipe excess glue
8. Optional:
 - a. Elmers school glue
 - b. Sewline Fabric Pencil trio
 - c. Gum eraser – usually sold in a pack of three. Bring all for ergonomic tip.
 - d. Stiletto
 - e. Portable iron/felt pad/board
 - f. Point turner for corners
 - g. Right angle ruler or ruler (~12 inches) with 45-degree marks. Please mark your rulers for easy identification.

Instructor supplied

1. Two small community projects
 - a. Kennel Quilt for Pagosa Springs Humane Society – 12 x 18 inches (70 inches long of 2.50-inch-wide binding)
 - b. Leaves in Time Perinatal Hospice – 21 x 25 inches (100 inches long of 2.50-inch-wide binding & contrasting flange)
2. 2.50-inch binding for both projects
3. Contrasting flange for Leaves in Time quilt
4. Forty-five-degree card stock corner guard
5. Beading

Note: You may bring your own project for any of the discussed binding methods.
Bring binding for the project.
